

# Factsheet HTML Guidance v1.0

## 1. Does your site run on a CMS (Content Management System)?

(Wix, Square-space, Wordpress, Umbraco, Expression Engine etc.)

### Yes

To add the content via your CMS (so the content looks like all the other pages on your site) we recommend that you purchase the **content only** version which will require you to copy and paste each individual page.

## 2. Do you have someone that looks after your website on your behalf?

(External agency, web designer etc.)

### Yes

To add the content to your website we recommend that you purchase the **content only** version which will require you to supply these files to your web masters and they will populate your website.

## 3. Do you have FTP functionality that will allow you to upload/add a whole folder/directory of files?

### Yes

Please download our [test files](#)\* which mirror the setup of our html products.

These files have been designed for use in an iframe on your website. All body and html margins have been removed so that the articles look seamless when loaded into the iframe.

We would recommend also adding the following script to the page head that has the iframe.

```
<script type="text/javascript">
    function resizeIframe(obj){
        obj.style.height = obj.contentWindow.document.body.scrollHeight + 'px';
    }
</script>
```

And also the onload trigger to the iframe element itself.

```
<iframe src="..." height="600" width="665" style="border:0px;" onload="resizeIframe(this)"></iframe>
```

If you are able to successfully upload these [test files](#) to your site and insert them into an 'iframe' within a new page, we recommend the **html** version. We will then proceed with designing/coding the files to match your websites content design.
